### VISION:

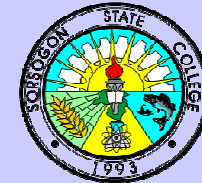

## Elite and Lean Programs

The College is bent on rationalizing and verticalization of its program offerings; It will introduce an Academy of Technology that will produce vital human resource workforce of the region with 100% guaranteed employability.

The existing 25 programs will be reduced to 20 programs, with Bachelor of Science in Computer Sciences as banner program for the Bulan Campus, and Bachelor of Science in Agriculture as a banner program in Castilla Campus. While doctoral program in Public Administration and Technology will be added to the offerings of the College.

### OWNERSHIP

Following normative costing, the College will maintain a lean bureaucracy of experts and dedicated public servants following the precepts of “*matuwid na daan*” of the Philippine President Benigno Simeon Aquino. The continuing development program for faculty and non-teaching staff will constitute immersions, faculty exchange programs, scholarships for research endowment; upgrading programs for non-teaching personnel.

Twenty-five percent (25%) of the College fund will be sourced from its revolving projects thru land utilization of idle lands as agri-park, and market driven research projects.

The successful interface of research-extension-production will remain to be a strong mechanism of growth and development of the College.
